Your child soon will begin a required unit on the recorder, a small wind instrument, in our weekly music class. A recorder, sterilized according to the recommendations of the local public health department, is provided for use by each child. Each child, therefore, will be assigned a numbered instrument.

Each student will need to provide a clean tube sock, athletic sock, or knee sock that is <u>at</u> <u>least 14 inches long from toe to cuff</u> to serve as a protective case for the recorder. I expect to assign recorders beginning January 28 with Mrs. Gendron's class. Your child will need to have a sock present in order to receive an instrument.



If you prefer, you may purchase a soprano recorder for your child at **Music & Arts**. If you are not internet active, I can provide you with a hard copy of *Buying a Recorder* upon request; otherwise, you may find it in the "Recorders" section of the Music web page that you can access through the Baucom home page. **Any child who wishes to use a personal recorder during our unit needs to bring it to me before 9:15 a.m. to have its pitch checked. All personal recorders will need to be approved by January 24.** A personal instrument will need to have a protective case as well; suggestions for recorder cases also are listed on the Music classroom web page.

In class, I will speak with your child concerning the care and responsibility necessary when using such materials. If any of these school-owned instruments are lost or damaged beyond normal use, they must be replaced, just as any textbook or library book and paid for by you and/or your child. The current replacement cost of a recorder is \$6.00. Please note that this price is as subject to change as those of the items on your grocery list or a gallon of gas. Otherwise there is no cost involved for supplies during this unit.

Below is a statement that must be **completed**, **signed by you**, **and returned to me before I will issue a school-owned recorder** to your child.

In addition, your child is responsible for having the instrument and its case present in order to learn during class.
